- **ListenNJNW**, powered by OverDrive, has downloadable audiobooks and e-books available for loan 24/7.
- **NAXOS Music Library** holds over 700,000 tracks from more than 320 labels.
- **Spoken Word Library** contains over 500 titles available anywhere, anytime.
- **World Language Catalog** is a developing catalog of books, magazines, and newspapers in Chinese, Korean, and Russian. (Coming soon: Japanese, Gujarati, and Hindi.)

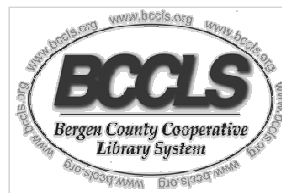
Ancestry.com Library Edition is the world's largest online history resource, offering a pathway to genealogical history, including census records, draft registrations, and citizenship and naturalization records.
